How does North American Power Meet Connecticut Renewable Portfolio Standard (RPS)?

To promote the development of renewable/clean sources, Connecticut, through legislation called the Renewable Portfolio Standard, requires all Suppliers to acquire specific percentages of energy from renewable resources. For calendar year 2018, the minimum RPS requirement is 25.0%.

Product Content

North American Power purchases renewable energy certificates that equals 100% of customer's electric usage from renewable sources. This product is composed of the below renewable resources*.
